

## **LONGREACH PRIME & STORE CATTLE SALE –21<sup>ST</sup> JULY 2010**

A yarding of 2100 cattle where drawn from Richmond, Winton, Hughenden, Local areas and as far South as Windorah. The Meatworks market was very buoyant with processors extremely keen on the lines of well finished Heavy cattle. The largest yarding of Bullocks seen this year attracted rates up to 174c/kg, with a majority of Bullocks over 600kg selling in the early 160's. The Feeder Steer Market had strong results with the best of the Heavy flat back Feeder Steers selling to a high of 180c/kg. The Cow market attracted fierce competition with the two main processors actively trying to secure as many good Cows as possible. An extreme pen of Santa Cows topped the market at 146c/kg. Southern Processors are still very keen in the market for Slaughter Heifers selling to a high of 159c/kg. The best of the Feeder Heifer sold to 171c/kg. Store Steers sold to strong Restocker competition with the best of the light store Steers selling to 178c/kg. A limited yarding of light Backgrounder Heifers met strong sales, topping at 170c/kg. One pen of Brahman Mixed aged Cows and Calves sold to \$637.50/unit.
