

Roma Store Sale August 3, 2010

A total of 5100 head were yarded at Roma's Store Sale with feedlot buyers noticeably more active this week.

Feeder steers in the 400-550kg range topped at 199c/kg and averaged 182c/kg (+3), while steers in the 350-400kg range reached 197c/kg and averaged 177c/kg (-3) and steers in the 280-350kg range reached 216c/kg and averaged 199c/kg (U/C). Weaner steers in the 220-280kg range reached 220c/kg and averaged 203c/kg (+3), while weaners under 220kg topped at 222c/kg and averaged 212c/kg (+3).

The Gobbert family, Amboola, Mitchell, sold Charolais steers to 220c for 262kg to return \$578/head.

The Lunney family, Mansfield, Surat, sold Droughtmaster-cross steers to 217c for 207kg to make \$449.

Consolidated Pastoral Co, Isis Downs, Isisford, sold Angus-cross steers to 214c and averaged 208c for 302kg to return \$629. They also sold Charolais-cross heifers to 190c for 295kg to make \$562.

Heifers in the 350-450kg range reached 195c and averaged 164c (U/C).

Heifers in the 280-350kg range topped at 192c/kg and averaged 168c/kg (-4).

Heifers in the 220-280kg range topped at 196c/kg and averaged 182c/kg (-5), while heifers under 220kg topped at 194c/kg and averaged 183c/kg (+2).

Bangor Cattle Co, Bangor, Mungallala, sold Charolais-cross heifers to 194c for 232kg to return \$452.

The Taylor family, Samac Downs, Wallumbilla, sold Simmental-cross heifers to 189c for 366kg to make \$693.

The Pukallus family, Warrabinda, Roma, sold Charolais-cross heifers to 158c for 400kg to return \$635.

Cows over 500kg hit 149c and averaged 146c (+11), while cows 400-500kg topped at 154c and averaged 133c (+4). Cows in the 300-400kg range made 133c and averaged 121c (-1).

Cows and calves sold to \$860 and averaged \$751/unit.

Bulls up to 400kg reached 186c to average 161c (+2).
